The Two Paths – One Leads to Blessing and Life. One Leads to Woe and Death.

1. Leading a spiritually deceptive life has both consequences here in this life and will carry on into eternity!
2. The Beatitudes that Jesus taught do not teach what so many people think they teach!
3. Jesus is teaching about becoming poor SPIRITUALLY – our spiritual portfolios.
4. Those who are spiritual hungry and poor
 - Those who are spiritually persecuted and mourning and how they really, honestly stand before God
 - These people see and acknowledge their spiritual poverty and related issues that have to do with the fact that there is nothing they can do and there is nothing they have of any value that can bring salvation.
 - These people hunger and thirst for Him
 - These Believers humbly weep over their sins as they understand the curse sin has brought us.
 - It is God, The Holy Spirit who has brought them to this point where they can actually be spiritually honest. What do YOU hunger for??
5. Our Almighty, Triune God desires to give exactly what is lacking in those who humbly respond in spiritual honesty!
6. Those who desire and live in spiritual honesty have the greatest gratification in and through God's Work and Sacraments here and now in this life and eternally in Heaven!
7. The world looks for so many other spiritual paths that ultimately lead to emptiness and life without the One True and Only God.
8. Jesus teaches and urges His followers to rejoice and leap for joy in the midst of persecution and hate:
 - the everyday struggles and hassles of life that are just part of this fallen world are not what Jesus talked about here. These are all resulting from sin.
 - We Believers have targets on us because of our faith.
 - Jesus teaches that anything bad that comes at us as a result of our faith and trust in Him.
9. The Believer's eternal reward after the struggles of this temporary life is bigger and more awesome than we can imagine. There is a promise that when persecution comes because of our faith in Christ, the Holy Spirit enables us to endure it, and even triumph over it.
10. Deceivers sometimes will think and teach that **they** somehow serve God. They believe that they and others are rich in what they have done and rely on their own good works and false beliefs for salvation – which will never be.
11. The end result of those following the deceptive path is eternally sad and tragic, because what they will have this side of eternity is tragically all they'll ever really have. There is no eternal value.
12. The path of blessing depends only on Jesus. Jesus Himself fulfilled ALL of the Beatitudes FOR US.

The Third Article of the Apostles' Creed (On Sanctification)

C I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

P *What does this mean?*

C I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way He calls, gathers, enlightens and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith. In this Christian Church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers.
