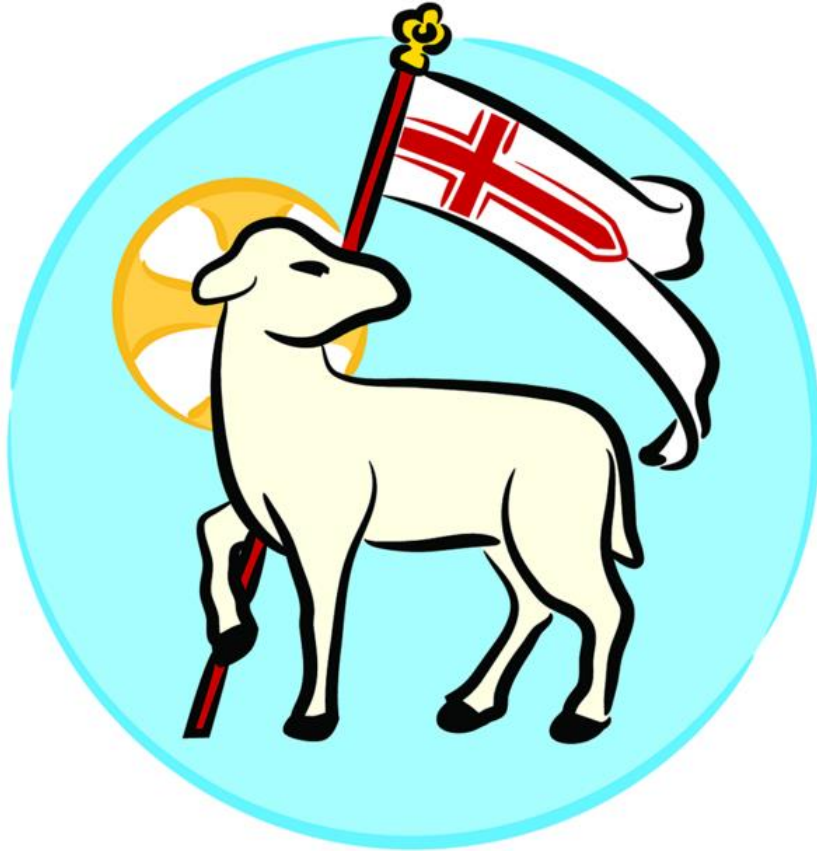

As We Gather – Many people in the world are deaf to God’s presence and certainly to His Word. Some people refused to believe when they physically met Jesus, as in today’s Gospel. Paul had to warn church leaders that opposition might even come from within, from wolves in sheep’s clothing. But by the grace of God in Scripture, we hear our Good Shepherd speaking to us about His grace and mercy. John’s vision of the Lamb’s eternal victory lets us hear the eternal praises of saints and angels in heaven. First Reading

Acts 20:17–35

¹⁷Now from Miletus [Paul] sent to Ephesus and called the elders of the church to come to him.

¹⁸And when they came to him, he said to them:

"You yourselves know how I lived among you the whole time from the first day that I set foot in Asia, ¹⁹servicing the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials that happened to me through the plots of the Jews; ²⁰how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you in public and from house to house, ²¹testifying both to Jews and to Greeks of repentance toward God and of faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. ²²And now, behold, I am going to Jerusalem, constrained by the Spirit,

not knowing what will happen to me there, ²³except that the Holy Spirit testifies to me in every city that imprisonment and afflictions await me. ²⁴But I do not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. ²⁵And now, behold, I know that none of you among whom I have gone about proclaiming the kingdom will see my face again. ²⁶Therefore I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all of you, ²⁷for I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole counsel of God. ²⁸Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood. ²⁹I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; ³⁰and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them. ³¹Therefore be alert, remembering that for three years I did not cease night or day to admonish everyone with tears. ³²And now I commend you to God and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. ³³I coveted no one's silver or gold or apparel. ³⁴You yourselves know that these hands ministered to my necessities and to those who were with me. ³⁵In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"

John 10:22–30

P The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the tenth chapter.
C Glory to You, O Lord.

22At that time the Feast of Dedication took place at Jerusalem. It was winter, 23and Jesus was walking in the temple, in the colonnade of Solomon. 24So the Jews gathered around him and said to him, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly." 25Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name bear witness about me, 26but you do not believe because you are not part of my flock. 27**My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.** 28I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. 29My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all, and no one is able to snatch them out of the Father's hand. 30I and the Father are one."

P This is the Gospel of the Lord.
C Praise to You, O Christ.

“My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.”

1. “All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way.”
2. John 10:25-30 (From today’s Gospel Reading)
3. “My sheep hear My voice.”
 - ALL the sheep know ***their*** shepherd’s voice, and only those sheep will follow that shepherd. Without the gift of saving faith, no one can hear the Shepherd.
 - The Holy Spirit enables us to hear the Shepherd and understand that His Law shows us our sin, and His Gospel points to the Saviour.
 - Those who do not hear the Shepherd falsely believe they can make it on their own as they reject God’s Word.
 - Even True Sheep can be deceived that they can stay away from God’s Word and Sacraments & do life apart from Christ’s church. That is rejecting God’s Words of Life.
4. “I know them.” YOU ARE KNOWN AND LOVED BY OUR TRIUNE GOD!!
5. So often we confess Christ as our Saviour and Lord, but do not really KNOW Him as Lord over every part of our life.
 - To know Him as Lord is to live in daily repentance...
 - allowing Him to move into the very center of life and family...
 - letting saving faith emanate from you and inform every aspect of life... which includes knowing God’s Word well, and proactively placing worship and your church home at the center as a top priority in your life & family, as Jesus designed our faith to be like.

Nicene Creed

☩ I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only-begotten Son of God, begotten of His Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God, begotten, not made, being of one substance with the Father, by whom all things were made; who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven and was incarnate by the Holy Spirit of the virgin Mary and was made man; and was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate. He suffered and was buried. And the third day He rose again according to the Scriptures and ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of the Father. WOMEN – Thank You that You hold on to us always as we follow You. Shepherd the flock of Your people, that we may live with one another according to the peace You have won for us. Bless and protect all pastors who speak to us on Your behalf.

MEN – Jesus, You are eternally incarnate before the throne of God, which is the seat of all power and authority in heaven and on earth. Govern the leaders of this world that they may humbly serve the people of every tribe, nation, and language who will one day stand in Your presence.

WOMEN – We pray for the sick, and all who suffer, that in Your tender mercy You would be at work in us always for good. Grant all who suffer to trust in Your promise that nothing is able to snatch us out of Your hand.

P Thank You for Your faithful people of every time and every place who now rest from their labors in Your nearer presence. Shepherd us through this life with the saints of every nation, tribe, people, and language that we may worship before Your throne on the great and terrible day of the Lord; for You live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
