

#### As We Gather

Without explaining Himself and to the surprise of those He chose, God decided to use the people who eventually became the nation of Israel to save all people. Likewise, He has graciously invited us and all people to join them, solely because we trust His promises. Recognizing that faith, not physical descent, is the factor that includes one in God's promises, Paul laments that most of his Jewish friends have rejected God's Son, Jesus Christ. To those who follow our Lord, the disciples learn in today's Gospel, God's grace even invites them to serve as His instruments in caring for the people around them. Today we rejoice in God's invitation to us, and we ask His blessings as we seek to extend His gracious invitation to those who do not yet know Christ as their Savior.

Epistle Romans 9:1–13

<sup>1</sup>I am speaking the truth in Christ—I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the Holy Spirit—
<sup>2</sup>that I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. <sup>3</sup>For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh. <sup>4</sup>They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises. <sup>5</sup>To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen.

<sup>6</sup>But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For not all who are descended from Israel belong to Israel, <sup>7</sup>and not all are children of Abraham because they are his offspring, but "Through Isaac shall your offspring be named." <sup>8</sup>This means that it is not the children of the flesh who are the children of God, but the children of the promise are counted as offspring. <sup>9</sup>For this is what the promise said: "About this time next year I will return and Sarah shall have a son." <sup>10</sup>And not only so, but also when Rebecca had conceived children by one man, our forefather Isaac, <sup>11</sup>though they were not yet born and had done nothing either good or bad—in order that God's purpose of election might continue, not because of works but because of his call— <sup>12</sup>she was told, "The older will serve the younger." <sup>13</sup>As it is written, "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated."

## The First Article of the Apostles' Creed (Creation)

- I believe in God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.
- **P** What does this mean?

<u>ALL –</u> I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them.

He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life. He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him. This is most certainly true.

#### **Gradual and Verse**

Romans 11:33, 36; Psalm 78:25

- P Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God!
- How unsearchable are His judgments and how inscrutable His ways!
- P For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things.
- To Him be glory forever. Amen.

- He sent them food in abundance. Alleluia.

## **Holy Gospel** *Matthew 14:13–21* (Jesus feeds the 5,000.)

- P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the fourteenth chapter.
- Glory to You, O Lord.
- P Now when Jesus heard this, He withdrew from there in a boat to a desolate place by Himself. But when the crowds heard it, they followed Him on foot from the towns. When He went ashore He saw a great crowd, and He had compassion on them and healed their sick. Now when it was evening, the disciples came to Him and said,
- "This is a desolate place, and the day is now over; send the crowds away to go into the villages and buy food for themselves."
- **P** But Jesus said,
- They need not go away; you give them something to eat."
- P They said to Him,
- "We have only five loaves here and two fish."
- P And He said.
- I "Bring them here to Me."
- Then He ordered the crowds to sit down on the grass, and taking the five loaves and the two fish, He looked up to heaven and said a blessing. Then He broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds. And they all ate and were satisfied. And they took up twelve baskets full of the broken pieces left over. And those who ate were about five thousand men, besides women and children.
- **P** This is the Gospel of the Lord.
- Praise to You, O Christ.

## Sermon - "Salvation by Grace, Not Law"

## **Prayer of the Church**

P Let us go to our heavenly Father with prayers, praise, and thanksgiving.

- <u>WOMEN –</u> With one another and our brothers and sisters around the world, for all God's promises, which endure forever, let us thank our gracious God.
- Thanks be to You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, for Your steadfast love.
- For all who face this day with little or no food, with poor shelter and tattered clothes, without caring support or necessities, dealing with ongoing oppression and persecution, struggling through long-term ills and sudden man-made or natural disasters, [including...], that our gracious God would visit, relieve, strengthen, and surround them with caring people and the precious Gospel, let us pray to the Lord.
- Hear our prayers for them and the longing in their hearts, gracious Lord. Use us and our gifts to be part of Your answer to their fervent prayers.
- **P** We bring all these things to You in the name of Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord who taught us to pray:
