

Holy Gospel

Mark 7:14-23

The Holy Gospel according to St. Mark, the seventh chapter.
 G Glory to You, O Lord.

¹⁴And he called the people to him again and said to them, "Hear me, all of you, and understand: ¹⁵There is nothing outside a person that by going into him can defile him, but the things that come out of a person are what defile him." ¹⁷And when he had entered the house and left the people, his disciples asked him about the parable. ¹⁸And he said to them, "Then are you also without understanding? Do you not see that whatever goes into a person from outside cannot defile him, ¹⁹since it enters not his heart but his stomach, and is expelled?" (Thus he declared all foods clean.) ²⁰And he said, "What comes out of a person is what defiles him. ²¹For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, ²²coveting, wickedness, deceit, sensuality, envy, slander, pride, foolishness. ²³All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."

P This is the Gospel of the Lord. **C** Praise to You, O Christ.

Sermon "What Defiles the Heart and Its Remedy" based on Mark 7:14–23 OUTLINE

- 1. Defiled, what a yucky word! Something that's been made bad... vile...
- 2. Religious leaders were often put in their place by Jesus for hypocritical behaviour and believing and teaching wrong things... especially for believing and teaching that the way to heaven is to follow a list of rules. Yet, in theirs and society's eyes, they were holy and above reproach.

- 3. What matters and defiles a person and makes you filthy and impure is what you think, say and do. Those things are what comes out of your heart and in God's eyes makes you defiled. The issue is not what's going in, but what's coming out!
- 4. The false idea of the innate goodness in a human heart is highlighted by Jesus in verses 20-23.
 - a. Most, if not all of these sins we DO deal with in our own lives.
 - b. We easily recognize these sins and defilement in others and forget about or miss it in us.
 - c. We even comfort and console ourselves as we either forget, or we compare the gravity of our sins compared to other people's sins... as if the lesser gravity of our sins makes us more righteous. That's the same issue the religious leaders had, and it shows just how bad we really are.
 - d. Sometimes people will choose to put on display and be proud of what defiles them. Others try to defend and justify what defiles them... maybe saying they are making themselves "real and relevant" to others... maybe doing comparisons with others' issues saying at least they're not as bad them... and shaming others for judging them... even saying God made them that way, when all along it serves sinful, selfcentered desires.
 - e. One use of God's perfect and Holy Law is to be able to examine ourselves:
 - in its light you can see how defiled we really are...
 - instead of justifying ourselves saying at least we are not as bad as so and so who does this and that, we hopefully are able to humbly, and in brokenness see what a chief of sinners we each are.
- 5. Civil Righteousness = outwardly keeping the rules (the religious leaders did this). But in God's eyes they were defiled. If Jesus told these squeaky-clean people that they had no hope, would you have any chance and hope at all apart from Christ?
- 6. No matter how righteous you seem to others and yourself, there is nothing you can say or do that can earn you forgiveness and salvation. Forgiveness, life, and salvation is only found in the righteousness of Jesus... received as a free gift from God to those who repent and trust in Jesus.
- 7. The words of Jesus on the cross, "It is finished," applies to you! In your baptism you were baptized into Jesus' redeeming death and resurrection. By God's grace and mercy, forgiveness, righteousness, and salvation is yours. Your hope is based on the fact that Jesus rose from the dead... He can't lie. There's nothing to add and improve on what Jesus has done for you. Jesus' victory is yours (imputed to you). God has declared you undefiled, holy, and innocent.
- 8. Although you live, fail and sin, "There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."
- 9. Anything that we do now is a get-to-do, not a got-to-do, because it is not about us and our pious wishes and good deeds. It's all a response to and about Jesus and what He has done.
