Welcome to Our Guest Preacher Today! The Rev. Jeffrey Miskus became President and Bishop of the English District in 2024 (the LC-MS District in which Risen Christ is a member congregation).

After ministering to congregations in Saskatchewan, Canada in the '90s, Bishop Miskus settled in Mississauga, Canada with his family, where he has been serving as pastor at Saint Mark Lutheran Church since 2000.

About the English District – There are 160 congregations in the English District, mostly in the USA. At one time the English District was an independent Lutheran Synod in North America, organized in 1888 as the "English Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri." Its history goes back to colonial times!

The English District is a non-geographical district and one of 35 districts of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod (LC-MS) (33 districts are within geographical boundaries). Member churches of the LC-MS are in both Canada and the USA and total over 6,000 congregations.



hear our prayer.




Lord's Prayer
