

Let us pray that our dear Father in heaven, for the sake of His beloved Son and in the power of His Holy Spirit, might richly bless this Lententide for us so that we may come to Easter with glad hearts and keep the feast in sincerity and truth.


Imposition of Ashes (Those who desire to receive ashes come forward. You may have them placed on your forehead or extend your hand to be placed on the top of your hand..)

As the ashes are imposed on the forehead of each person in the sign of the cross, the pastor says, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

Suggested Personal Prayer to say silently in your seat after the imposition of ashes upon your forehead.

Grant me the spirit of true repentance to acknowledge our sins and to find in You forgiveness and restoration, wholeness and peace; through the merits of Jesus Christ, our Lord and our Redeemer. Ash Wednesday Sermon

"The Good News of a Savior Who Covers Our Sin" based on Genesis 3:1–13, 21 OUTLINE

- **1.** Like Adam and Eve, our sin covers us with guilt and fills us with shame.
- **2.** As Adam and Eve couldn't hide themselves from God or justify themselves by blaming others, we cannot cover up or excuse our sin.
- **3.** In providing garments of skin for Adam and Eve, God previewed how he would provide a covering for man's sin.
- **4.** In Christ, God has freely given the covering we sinners need. In Christ, God Has Covered Your Sins and Clothed You in Righteousness.
- **5.** Clothed in Christ's righteousness, we can look forward to standing before God when we join his throng in paradise.
